#### **CLEOBURY GARDENERS: RISK ASSESSMENT 2025**

#### **OVERARCHING PRINCIPLES**

- Assessment of risk adopts the two categories of:
  - likelihood of it happening
  - o consequences of it happening
- Scoring for 'likelihood of it happening' as 1, 2, 3
  - 1 unlikely
  - 2 fairly unlikely
  - o 3 likely
- Scoring for 'Consequences if it happened' as 1, 2, 3
  - 1 low, need first aid
  - o 2 medium, need medical assistance (such as broken bones or stitches)
  - 3 high death, paralysis etc
- Risk lever calculation: likelihood x consequences = risk level
